The 2016 Operating Revenues are \$727,350 compared to \$486,821 in 2016. The majority of the increase represents the use of fund balance to provide for Capital Projects previously voter approved (see F-5). The basic operating expenditure plan is \$402,500 from \$486,821, a decrease of \$84,321. The decrease overall of operating expenditures is caused by a decrease in debt service.

2. Complete a brief statement on the impact the proposed Annual Budget will have on the Amount to be Raised by Taxation to support the district budget and on the Restricted and Unrestricted Fund Balance(s). Explain increases or decreases in the tax rate and utilization of fund balances. Amount to be raised by taxation in 2017 is \$\frac{\$463,000}{2017}\$ which is the same as in 2016. The proposed tax rate in 2017 is \$\frac{.197}{.197}\$ (19.7\$\varepsilon\$) per \$100 assessed valuation vs. \$\frac{.197}{.197}\$ (19.7\$\varepsilon\$) per \$100 assessed valuation in 2016. Unrestricted surplus utilized in 2016 of \$\frac{\$154,350}{.350}\$ compared to 2015 of \$\frac{\$23,821}{.350}\$ is higher due to the need in 2017 to supplement funding for voter approval Capital Projects not recurring in 2017. In addition, \$\frac{\$110,000}{.100,000}\$ of Reserve for Capital Outlay is being used to offset \$\frac{\$305,000}{.305,000}\$ of projects approved in 2016.
